

# About Educational Packets

Associated with each tea that Indonique offers through schools is an Educational Packet designed with Educators from around the country using tea as a vehicle to engage and educate students.

## Why Tea?

Tea is a healthy tangible commodity that is manufactured in numerous regions around the world with diverse cultures, environments and ecosystems. ## Educational Packets

Educational Packets under development can be broken down into two main categories: Tea Basics and Tea Regions.

### Tea Basics

#### **Tea 101 (K-5)**

Provides students with a basic overview of where tea comes from, tea types, and tea history and its impact on the world.

#### **Tea 102 (Grade 6 and up)**

A more detailed look at the tea plant, its chemistry, plant biology, health benefits etc...

### Tea Regions

The course places an emphasis on the specific regions that programT42 will impact for a particular campaign.

Suggested Campaign Approach:

## Fill the Cup Campaign

**Materials Needed:** 1 large poster board  
1 packet of index cards  
Markers, crayons, pens, pencils, paints (any medium)

## Instructions:

1. Recreate the “Fill the Cup” teacup depicted on the above web page
2. For each tea box sold, students can create a paper sugar cube (half an Index Card) from index cards with their names written on it and attach to teacup.
3. Download and distribute educational packets. For each educational packet completed, a student can add another sugar cube (quarter index card) to the cup. Get a corporate sponsor to contribute for each educational packet completed by a student (suggest \$.25/packet-approximately one meal per child).
4. Teachers can tally amount being collected and associated humanitarian goals.
